- All participants 15 years of age and younger must be on a float or in a vehicle. If they are walking they must have an adult present.
- All vehicles entered by non-campus organizations must be decorated and identified with company or organization name legibly written or printed.
- All towed floats must have safety hinges on the hitch.
- It is mandatory that fire resistant materials be used to decorate floats and vehicles.
- No talking or texting on cell phones while driving vehicles.
- Each unit must maintain a distance of one car length between units.
