

Board Policy S-10 School Fees Schedule

2025-2026

HIGH SCHOOLS

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The maximum annual amount that a student may be charged is \$3,500.00.
2. A student may be eligible to have any fee listed on this schedule waived. Any denial of a fee waiver can be appealed.
3. Each time a student registers for a course or activity the board approved fee may be assessed.
4. All fees listed are the maximum amount charged per student for each class or school-sponsored activity. Actual amount charged may be less.
5. Any payment for student participation in a class, program, or activity is a fee and is subject to the fee waiver requirement. For information on fee waivers and other details, contact your school administrator.
6. All students are responsible to pay for any loss, breakage, or damage they cause to school property. Loss breakage, or damage is not subject to the waiver requirement.
7. Donations are permissible in both elementary and secondary schools, but all such requests are voluntary. A student may not be excluded from an activity or program because they did not make a donation.
8. The district does not allow required individual student fundraising. Students may be required to participate in group fundraising.
