


## How to set up MyIvy

## Compliance







Enter your legal First Name, Last Name, Ivy Tech C Number, *you will include the C and the first number is 0 (zero) not the letter "O"*, date of birth, and zip code. Remember all personal information must match the information from the Ivy Tech system. If you do not know your C Number, you can contact your school counselor or reference your Dual Enroll.com account at <a href="ivytech.dualenroll.com">ivytech.dualenroll.com</a> to locate it.




The following page will display your Ivy Tech email. Please make note of your Ivy Tech email, as it will be required to log into your account. You will also be asked to add a Recovery Email Address and Recovery Phone. It is recommended to use a personal email versus your High School email and your Cell number for the Recovery Phone. If


• To validate your identity, Ivy Tech will need to send you a validation code. The screen below will provide the option to send an email or text (or voice) to receive the validation code. Make sure to select I'm not a robot, then select the Next button.




• Check your email (may need to check your Spam/Junk) or text messages for the validation code. Once you have located your validation code, enter it, then click Next.
