




Sierra Teller Ornelas

- 1 of the first 2 Native Americans with documented tribal ancestry to serve in Congress

Our Scholastic Bookfair is Coming Soon!

Our FLA Bookfair is coming to the FLA Library at the beginning of November. The bookfair will begin on Thursday, 11/4 and will close on Monday, 11/15.

Important Info

Visitation restrictions – Having an in-person bookfair is important to us as we return to in-person learning. And our fall Scholastic bookfair is the main fundraising event for the FLA Library. Due to Covid restrictions, the bookfair will only be open to families during the times listed below: 7:00 a.m. – 7:45 a.m. 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m. 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

We will be open late for families on Tuesday, 11/9 from 5:00 p.m – 8:00 p.m. **Masks are required for bookfair visits.**

K-8 students will come to the bookfair on Thursday, 11/4 and Friday, 11/5, with their classes. They can buy books that day or just browse. If they wish to purchase later, they will have an opportunity to return the next week.

E-wallet – Most people don't carry cash anymore. That's why we're using a digital payment option for our school. Parents can create eWallets for students to shop the Fair, and every eWallet created means kids will have the opportunity to choose more books they want to read!

• Parents create an account for their student and set a spending limit. It's a secure, cash-free, digital payment option.

You can set up eWallets now through the last day of your in-school Fair.

• Students can shop with their eWallets any day of the Fair; once the Fair ends, unused funds become a gift card balance for a future Bookfair.

• Why? Because parents don't always have cash on hand to give their kids. (And let's be honest ... kids sometimes misplace their money.)
