PERMIT PARKING North Parking Lot / Morning Drop Off SCHOOL DAYS

Our North Parking Lot is now a Parking Permit ONLY lot. All vehicles parked in the North Lot during school days form 7:15am-4:15pm must have a FLA parking decal. Parents

who need to park must park either in the parking spaces in front of the school or in the South lot (lot closest to the baseball field). Parents during morning carpool ALL Elementary Students MUST be dropped off in front off the school using the carline, if you wish to walk your child in you MUST park in the South Lot or in Front of the school. Elementary Students are **NOT** to be dropped off in the North Lot in the mornings. Only Middle School and High School students can be dropped off in the North Lot in the mornings. This is a rolling drop off ONLY, you may NOT park in the north lot to drop your child off. Thank you!
