# COUNSELORS CORNER

Falls Lake Academy will participate in the statewide College Application Week cosponsored by College Foundation of North Carolina (CFNC) and the Carolinas Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (CACRO) during October 15<sup>th</sup>—October 19<sup>th</sup>.

As part of the CFNC-CACRAO college access initiative, Falls Lake Academy will work with its seniors on Thursday, October 18<sup>th</sup> to complete and submit online at least one college application each using the career and college information and planning site, CFNC.org. Mrs. Broadway, our CFNC representative for Granville county, will also be on campus from 10-12 that day to assist students with the application process.

The goal of the program is to get more students applying to North Carolina colleges early in their senior year. During this event, students may apply to any of North Carolina's 58 community colleges, 36 independent colleges, and 16 state universities in which they are interested.

### **Reminders about library fines:**



Beginning this school year, the FLA library will be collecting fines for late books.

- 1. All books will be circulated for a two-week period.
- 2. Books will be eligible for renewal for at least two more periods, assuming the book is not on hold for another patron.
- 3. Students will be given a five-school-day grace period before fines accrue.
- 4. Students/parents will be notified when books become overdue. Our library management software will send an automatic email each week that books are overdue.
- 5. Students/parents can check their currently out/overdue materials at any time by logging into our Destiny our Library Management Software.
  - A. Go to Falls Lake Academy, Click on Links, Click on Library Catalog
  - B. Login is student's firstnamelastname (all one word) and the password is password.
- 6. Fine schedule is as follows: *no change will be available* so please send exact amount for late fees.
  - A. Early Readers/Leveled Readers/Picture Books: .05 per school day, per book, with a maximum of \$2.00.
  - B. Intermediate Books: .05 per school day, per book, with a maximum of \$3.00 per book
  - C. Young Adult Books: .10 per school day, per book, with a maximum of \$5.00 per book.
- 7. Lost/damaged books can either be replaced or paid for with replacement value.
- 8. Students with excessive fines (for example, over \$5.00) will not be allowed to check out books until fines are satisfied.
- 9. Students will get a system generated receipt upon payment of any fine.

Library fines will be used for library programming to encourage literacy, reading, and research in our K-5 students.


