Message from Mrs. Hobgood

Dear Parents,

Falls Lake Academy receives Title I funds for our elementary grades. The federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) requires school districts to notify parents/legal guardians of children attending Title I schools of their right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers and paraprofessionals who instruct their child. Falls Lake Academy will provide you with this information in a timely manner upon request. Specifically, you have the right to request the following information about each of your child's core academicsubject teachers/paraprofessionals:

- Whether the teacher meets the state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grades and core academic subjects he/she teaches.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency status because of special circumstances.
- The teacher's college major, whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- Whether paraprofessionals/teacher assistants provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications.

In addition, the law requires that all schools that receive Title I funds provide notification to every parent in the school whose child is being taught for four or more weeks by a teacher who is not "Highly Qualified". Falls Lake Academy is committed to providing quality instruction for all students.




