## Message from Mrs. Hobgood

#### Dear Parents,

It's November already! Can you believe it? Here are a few updates/reminders as we head into the cooler months:

#### Carpool reminders:

- As temperatures get cooler, many families are likely to have the heat turned up in their vehicles. Please be aware that this affects the temperature readings of all individuals in the vehicle. As you prepare for student drop-off, please roll your windows down as you approach the temperature station. Turn down your heat and remove head coverings. This will ensure that the reading on the thermometer is accurate. You only get one recheck before being sent home.
- Please make sure you are following the directions of all the stop sign holders in our car line. We have had several parents running stop signs which puts our students in danger.
- Fourth and fifth grade parents can use the North lot for drop off if you choose.

#### Mask reminders/updates:

- Please pack an extra mask daily just in case something happens to the first one.
- The local health department strongly discourages the use of gaiter masks (one piece masks that go all the way around the head and rest on the neck when not in use) because they put the wearer at greater risk. Cloth masks with ear loops and no vents are the best choice.
- Students are doing a GREAT job of remembering to bring their masks! Keep up the great work.

#### Winter Gear:

- Cooler mornings will require jackets etc. Please make sure that coats and gloves are labeled with your child's name. Many students get warm during recess and take off jackets that end up in our lost and found.
- It is important to wash jackets and gloves on a regular basis since they are traveling to and from school. Protect your family from germs by washing often!

And finally, November is a season of giving thanks. I would like to say how grateful the staff at FLA is for the support of our families over the last 7 months. We are thankful to be part of such a caring community during uncertain times. Happy Thanksgiving to everyone!


