### **REGISTRATION**

- Fall ASP Registrations will be live on August 22, 2022.
- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis with a completed/paid registration.
- If you register for a class that has a separate supply fee, please place your check made out to the vendor/instructor in the designated envelope at the Lower School front desk prior to the first class.

We make every effort to offer a variety of classes to students. However, a program may be canceled due to low enrollment. You will be notified and provided a complete refund if this occurs.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

Parents may transfer or cancel an ASP up to one day prior to the first day of the ASP for any reason. A complete refund of the class tuition will be given for cancellations, minus the administration fee, which is non-refundable.

If the cancellation is received on or after the first day of the After School Program, there will be no refund of the class tuition. If you want to switch classes after a session has begun, you will pay the full amount for both classes.

Once an ASP has begun, there will be no refund, prorated amount, or credit for all or part of the ASP, including changing from program to program:

- if he/she is dismissed for violation of school policies.
- if he/she is dismissed because the ASP instructor cites discipline issues or inappropriate behavior.
- if he/she is out sick for all/part of an ASP session.
- if the parent chooses to have the child leave for all or part of the session for any reason.

Please review the entire ASP schedule carefully before you register. Look at the descriptions and the day(s) of the week the ASP takes place. Make sure the days and dates work with your schedule.

### **DISMISSAL/PARENT PICK-UP**

At the conclusion of each class, ASP teachers will escort participants to the ECLC carpool. If your child is not picked up within 5 minutes of the class ending, we will escort him/her to the corresponding After Care class. You will be billed \$16.80 for After Care drop-in as applicable.
