6-8th Grade Artwork – For Exhibition Only

- Art pieces are to be 8x10 as directed by your school art teacher.
- Art pieces from the 6-8th grade group will be collected, delivered to the Arboretum and returned to the classroom by each classroom art teacher
- 2-dimensional art only; any medium
- Art entry forms should be submitted in a plastic sleeve taped to the back of the piece

9-12th Grade Artwork – Eligible for People's Choice Awards

- Contest art pieces are to be a minimum of 8.5x11 and a maximum of 11x17
- All pieces should include a 2" mat in the color of your choice
- 2 dimensional art only; any medium
- Art entry forms should be submitted in a plastic sleeve taped to the back of the piece
- Sleeves will be provided at submission location if you do not have one
- Parents or art teachers should drop off artwork, with entry form at:
NHC Arboretum, 6206 Oleander Drive, Wilmington NC on
Wednesday, September 28, 2022, between 3 and 6 pm.
- All 9-12th grade student artwork "as a whole" will be eligible for People's Choice Award.
- First, Second and Third Place ribbons for the People's Choice Awards will be given on Sunday morning of the art show. No monetary awards will be given for student awards.
- Permission is requested to photograph the winning student with their art piece at the time of pickup.
- Winners will be contacted at the contact information provided on the entry form.

In the event a patron expresses an interest in purchasing a student's artwork, the Art Committee will contact the parent or guardian on the application to provide the contact information of the patron. It will then be the option of the parent or guardian, with the permission of the student, to make arrangements for the sale of the art piece. The Friends of the NHC Arboretum, nor the Wilmington Art Association will be a part of any sale of student art other than to provide the parent or guardian of the youth artist with contact information of the person interested in purchasing the art piece. No student contact information will be disclosed other than what is displayed with their art piece.

As a thank you to the Art Teachers for encouraging participation in the Show, the school of the teacher with the most cumulative "People's Choice" votes for all their students' artwork combined will receive a monetary award. First place will receive \$100; second place will receive \$75 and third place will receive \$50.
