





Learning Together

- *Morning / Classroom meetings: greetings, welcome letter from teacher, daily schedule, calendar, counting, weather, reinforcing literacy skills*
- *Mini-lessons: Read aloud by teacher, modeling a skill, phonics instruction*
- *Work period: differentiation, conferencing, small-group instruction, choices of activities, centers activities, learning games, use of tech*
- *Closing share: students demonstrate their learning*

- *Positional words (above, below, next, behind, in front)*
