What is Nest Time?



Instructional scheduled time for students to:

- Make up missed assignments, tests, labs, quizzes, presentations, and seminars
- Review knowledge and concepts
- Practice skills
- Participate in study sessions to prepare for assessments or tasks
- Enjoy focused and guided work time and feedback on projects
- Meet with teachers to discuss study skills and success strategies
- And more!

When is Nest Time?

Nest Time is offered on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays** during the school year.

Nest is either choice days or grade level/school wide activities.

What is a Choice Day?

Choice Days are for Lab Make-Ups, Study Halls, Test Review, etc.

On weeks we have **Choice Days**, students will choose by Wednesday afternoon (3:45pm) which offerings they wish to attend for the projected choice days.

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Student Expectations

- Be on time
- Participate
- Follow teacher directions
- Come prepared
- Stay on task
- If you finish early, remain in the room and study for another class.

Student Attendance



- Attendance will be taken during Nest Time and will have the same expectations as a class.
- *5 unexcused tardies = Lunch Detention*
- *5 unexcused absences = Lunch Detention*

Selection of Theatre on Choice Days



- Students that were earning a C or higher in all of their classes at Mid-Term 1 will have the option of signing up for the Theatre 1401.
- This request will be sent to Ms. Little through Enriching Students.
- Students will be required to check-in for attendance and remain in the Theatre for the duration of Nest.

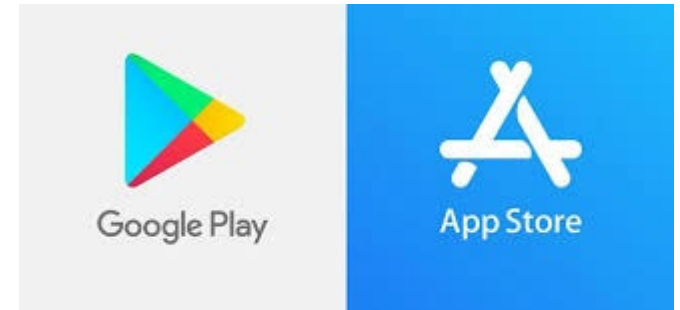

- **First 3** letters of your first name
- **Last 2** digits of your grad year
- **@issaquah.wednet.edu.**

For example: Harry Potter, 9th grader = **potthar25@issaquah.wednet.edu**).


Your password is the same one you use to log on to a district computer. If you haven't logged on yet this school year, be aware that your password was reset at the beginning of the year to your student ID #

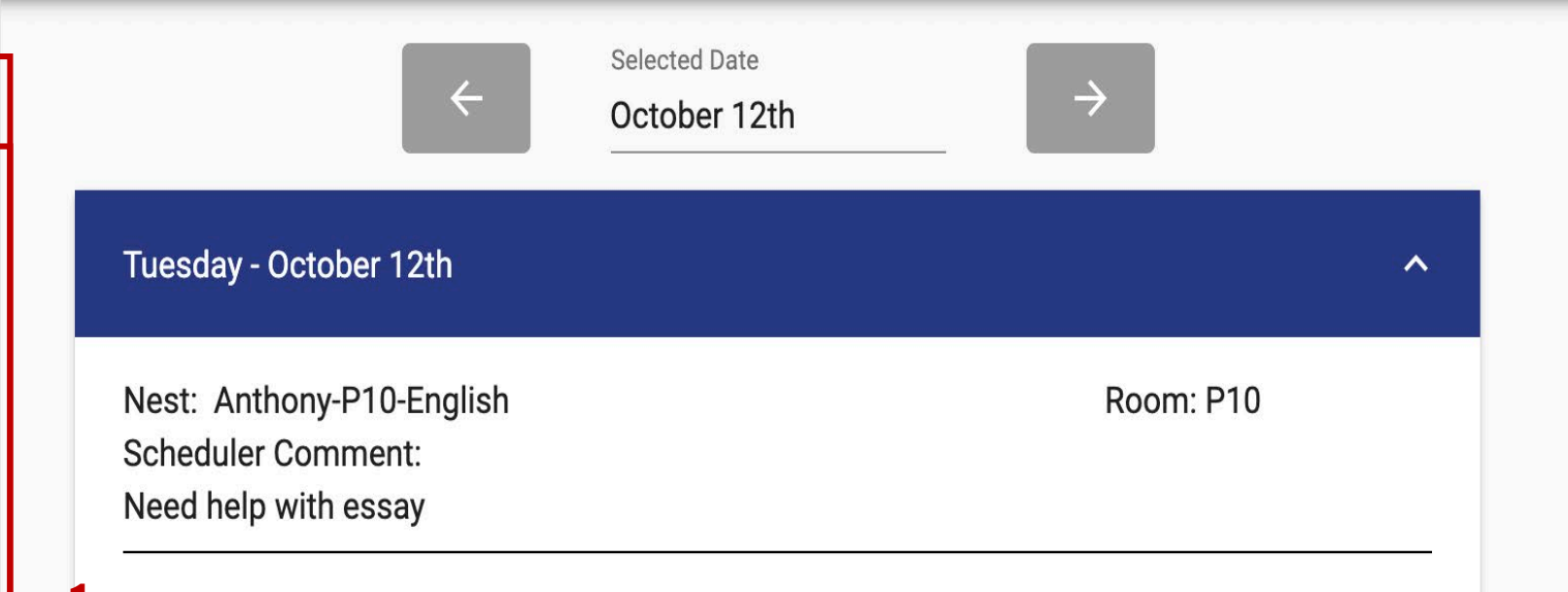

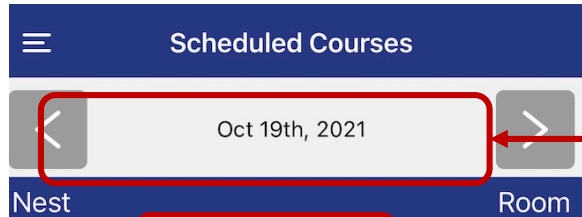

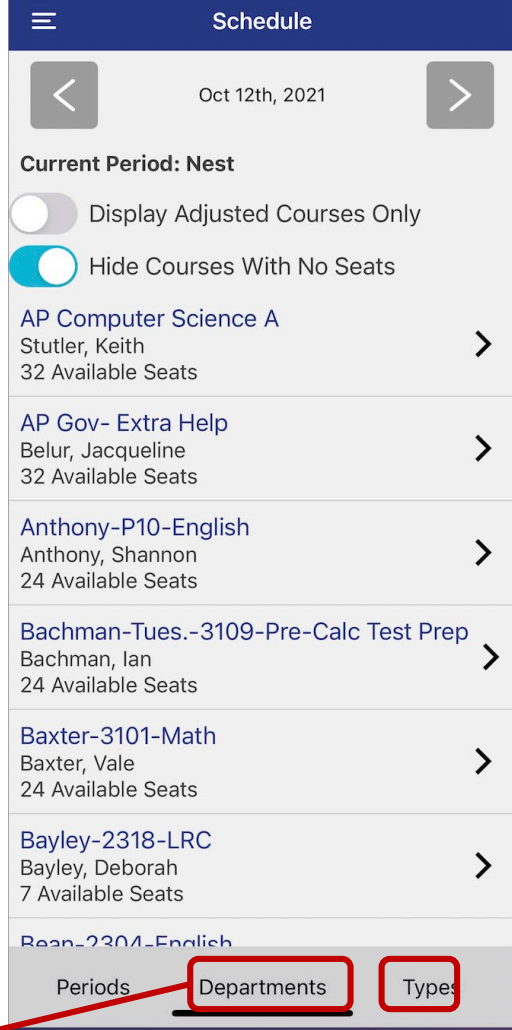
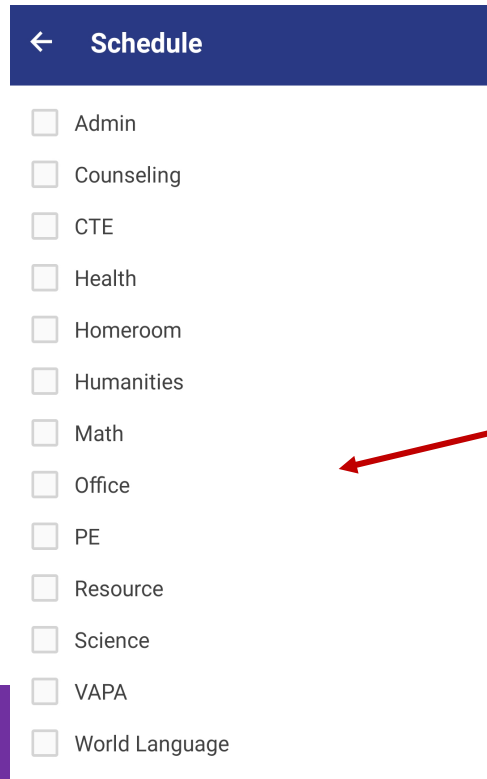

If you are not scheduled by then, a teacher will do it for you.

Nest Time Questions



How will I know where to go for Nest Time?

If you are unable to access your login information, you can ask your 1st or 6th period teacher before leaving for Nest or check the print outs near the front office.

What if I have an appointment during Nest and have to leave early?

Nest absences work the same way as regular absences. Your adult should contact the school in advance and you will need to pick up an early dismissal slip from the attendance office that morning.



Nest Time Questions

What if a teacher requested me, but I have to make up something with another teacher also?

Talk to your teachers! You may be able to schedule over the first teacher's request, if it's not urgent, or work out a way to split your time during Nest that day.
