7:56am - Any students arriving at 7:56am or after will be marked tardy


2:30pm - Dismissal begins

## **Arrival Procedures**

All students entering the building who would like to eat breakfast should report to the cafeteria.

Students in *grades K-2* who do not want breakfast should report to the cafeteria.

Students in *grades 3-4* who do not want breakfast should report to the library.



#### Dismissal Procedures

Student dismissal begins at 2:30pm

- Buses will be dismissed first
- Parents should loop around the parking lot and remain in their vehicle. Students will be escorted to the curb and release in the order of the cars in the line up.





## Free Student Breakfast and Lunch

Keystone Central has been approved by PDE for the Community Eligibility Program (CEP). Families will NOT need to fill out a free or reduced meal application. All students will receive free breakfast and lunch for the 2022-2023 school year. Students will continue to have the option to purchase ala carte foods/beverages, but must have money in their lunch accounts to pay for these items.

- 10 Total Absences = Letter informing of required doctor's excuses for any additional absences



## **Educational Trip**

- Submit an Educational Trip Form a minimum of 5 school days prior to the trip.
- Up to 7 days may be approved per year
- May be denied if more than 10 absences, 3 or more unexcused absences, or not in good academic standing.

#### Back-to School Updates:

Throughout the school year, our Reading Intervention Team will be sharing reading strategies, resources and at home activities to help build and support your child's reading.
