MISCELLANEOUS

- All students will receive in-person instruction with no virtual option
- School begins for students on Wednesday, 9/7 - a single session day, ending @ 12:10
- Thursday, 9/8, and Friday, 9/9, are full days, including lunch and ending @ 2:40 pm
- Breakfast Club doors open at 7:15 am daily
- Doors open for all students at 8:00 am and homeroom begins at 8:10 am
- Students should enter the building according to the following:
 - ^ 6th grade – Main entrance
 - ^ 7th grade – left/west Music Hall entrance
 - ^ 8th grade – right/east Cafeteria entrance
- Student schedules have been available via the Realtime Portal since 8/17/22 following the acknowledgment/input of required info
- Back-to-School Night will take place on Tuesday, September 13th, at 6:30 pm. A hard copy of this [letter](#) will go home with your child(ren) on the first day of school.



BREAKFAST CLUB

- Breakfast and Lunch are NOT free this year.
- It is highly recommended that money is added to your child’s account via [Maschio’s cashless option](#).
- The Breakfast Club is available to all students between 7:15 and 7:50. Students may be dropped off in the front of the building during those times and walk through the front doors to the cafeteria.
- A variety of breakfast options are available to purchase (or free/reduced depending on the student's eligibility via this [application](#) or via <https://lyndhurst.payschools.com/>.)
- Students may also sit in the cafeteria with a home breakfast or without eating to complete assignments, study or socialize quietly with friends.
- At 8 am, the Breakfast Club is released to go to their lockers and then to homeroom.
- Breakfast Club will begin on their first full day of school, Thursday, 9/8.

EMAIL, MICROSOFT & GOOGLE LOGIN INFORMATION

All applications can also be found under "District Shortcuts" on our webpage at www.lyndhurstschools.net.

To log into the chromebook, open the device and use the following credentials:

Username: FirstnameLastname@lyndhurstschools.net

Password: the password you created for your school email

A student's email address is:

FirstnameLastname@lyndhurstschools.net and will be used as the username for both Google and Microsoft.

Students can follow these steps:

To access email (<https://mail.lyndhurstschools.net> under Student and Staff Email)

Username: Firstname [space] Lastname

Password: Password from above (to change the password, follow these [steps](#))

To access Google:

When logging into Google, a student only needs to type her/his email address. After typing in the email address, Google will redirect the login to Microsoft where the student will be prompted (a second time) to re-enter email address and password.

Students should expect to receive **Google Classroom invitations**, if they have not already. They should accept the invitations and read any posted information. Teachers will review this when school begins.

Students/Parents do not have to log in to fill out the form.



EXTENDED HOMEROOM

Extended homeroom will take place throughout the first week of school, on 9/7, 9/8 and 9/9. On these days, there will be no 1st period, however, by the end of the week, because of the rotation, students will have seen all of their teachers.

During extended homeroom, students will review:

- Locker numbers and combinations and have an opportunity to practice opening and closing them (via the Student Portal once opened)
- Cycle days, schedule rotation, periods, PE/Health teachers and room locations
- Lunch processes and procedures
- Fire drill, evacuation and lock down procedures
- Chromebook, email & Google Classroom logins
