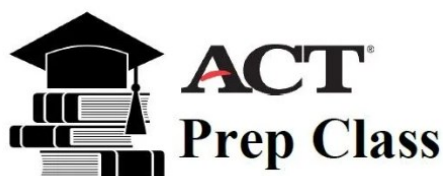

3. There are no refunds once the class has begun.

Signing up for the prep class does NOT sign you up for the ACT TEST, you must do that separately and PAY at the ACT website listed below:

- Each session will consist of 4-5 consecutive classes held on Wednesdays after school.
- Space is limited to 35 students per session.
- Seating is determined on a first come first serve basis. There are no "waiting lists."
- The first session is reserved for seniors.
