
WHERE SHOULD THEY VOTE? AT SCHOOLS?

WHAT WILL IT COST?

The total Referendum cost is approximately \$8 million. It is anticipated that the project will be funded with capital reserve, and state debt service aid (approved for up to 40% on eligible project costs), which would result in no tax increase for the residents.

WHY NOW?

The Referendum addresses the District's critical needs. A passing vote this year ensures the District can take advantage of current Debt Service Aid funding and allows the District to bundle projects together to leverage economies of scale.
