All businesses within the Town are required to obtain a zoning permit. This is to ensure that the business conforms to the Zoning Regulations.

- Certain businesses may only need to notify the Planning & Zoning Office of their intentions and may receive approvals or sign off on a Trade Name Certificate.
- Other businesses may be required to obtain Planning & Zoning Commission (PZC) approval. You will be provided with the appropriate checklist and fee schedule.

If your business is proposed within the Village District Zones (Town Center and West Suffield Center) this board reviews your zoning application and provides advisory recommendations to the PZC, under the following conditions: it is a new building; exterior changes to existing buildings; site work changes like parking lots, and new permanent signs.
