- **Inspection of Town Buildings:** *Valley Falls Park at 300 Valley Falls Road and Camp Newhocca at 185-195 Grier Road*
- **Inspection/Observations for Valley Falls Park and Valley Falls Barn**
 1. Bath-houses and Life-guard buildings are in good condition.
 2. Gazebo needs a fresh coat of paint and regular cleaning of the ceiling is recommended to remove bird nests and the accumulating droppings. Also, regular removal of hornet/wasp/bee nests is recommended.
 3. Valley Falls Barn: this building is beautifully maintained. The only issue to report is that batteries are needed in Exit Signs on the first floor and second floor.
