Cross Country:

The cross country team competed on Tuesday at the Ben Logan Invitational. The girls team got their first win of the season, over Tecumseh, led by top ten finishes from Hazel Lightle and Olivia MacKendrick. Sara Hildebrand, Emily Hughes, and Aubrie Cayten also scored for the team. Landon McKellop was a medal winner with a 13th place finish in the boys race.

The cross country team competed at the Bob Schul invitational on Saturday. Hazel Lightle led the team with a 22nd place finish out of 247 runners. Olivia MacKendrick finished in 45th place. Also scoring for the Hillclimbers were Sara Hildebrand, Emily Hughes, and Aubrie Cayten as the girls team picked up four more wins on the season. At the home meet on Tuesday Hazel Lightle, Olivia MacKendrick, and Sara Hildebrand took the top three spots among girls in the race, finishing 1st through 3rd. Landon McKellop represented UJHS in the boys races, finishing 159th out of 343 runners at the invitational and 3rd out of 9 runners at the home meet.

Urbana City School Parents/Guardians:

We are pleased to have an opportunity to provide library cards to Urbana students! With a library card, students can check out books, audio books, eBooks, music CDs, and access the Library's many online resources.

We know that many students already have Champaign County Library cards. If you are unsure if your child has a card or need to check on the status of the card, please contact the library.

Did you our child misplace your library card? During the month of September 2022, the library will be giving away FREE replacement cards to anyone!

We have two options for your child to receive a card.

Option 1: Apply online for a library card for your student if they do not already have one. You can go to our website at champaigncountylibrary.org and click on Catalog. In the upper right corner of the page, click on [Create Account](#) and enter the child's information. A temporary card number will be assigned. The actual library card will be mailed to you. By registering online, you are agreeing to abide by the library policies.

Option 2: Visit either of the Champaign County Library locations.

The Main Library hours are Monday-Thursday 9am-8pm, Friday-Saturday 9am-5pm. The North Lewisburg Branch Library is open Monday-Wednesday 4pm-8pm, Thursday & Saturday 10am-2pm.
