2022 HALL OF HONOR

STEVE GOSSELIN, '75



Steve spent much of his career in a variety of marketing-related, management positions for Caterpillar Inc. heavy equipment, engines, parts & service, and dealer distribution. In these capacities, Mr. Gosselin provided critical leadership in strengthening and aggressively growing Caterpillar's aftermarket parts and product support business. His success can be best measured by his advocacy for people engagement and development, continuous process improvement, and his influence on the strength of the Caterpillar and Cat brands globally. Throughout his career, Gosselin also devoted considerable time and effort to community non-profit organizations including the Heart of Illinois United Way, and advisory support to his alma mater Eastern Illinois University. Since his retirement in 2015, he has served on the board and executive committee of A Step Beyond, a non-profit organization supporting children whose lives have been impacted by poverty. A Step Beyond provides students 10 years of holistic, creative youth development, third grade through high school graduation. The program's mission is 100% student high school graduation and acceptance into higher level education. Gosselin's post-career passion is to support youth who have a desire for a successful life but lack the opportunity.

JOHN HEATH, '70



As a high school band director for over 30 years, beginning in Southern Illinois and continuing in the Fox Valley area, John Heath, Class of 1970, has impacted the lives of thousands of music students. He has often stated that one of the joys of being a high school music teacher was that he had the privilege of teaching his students their entire high school career, watching their growth as musicians, students, and individuals with limitless potential. Along with his much lauded teaching career, John has also impacted many students through his years as a director at summer music camps such as the Illinois Summer Youth Music in Champaign/Urbana and the Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp in Michigan. Through his leadership and mentorship at these camps, Heath has promoted friendship, goodwill, and understanding through cultural exchange and the universal language of the Arts. He has also participated in the Blue Lake International Program which involved a large group of American teenagers from around the country. Heath organized and created a first time band, and then headed off to Europe to perform. This experience shaped his students' worldview and fostered an understanding of connectivity through music. Recognized with many awards and commendations, Heath's positive leadership, joyous spirit, and musical acumen contributed greatly to the profound impact music has had on the thousands of youth under his tutelage.

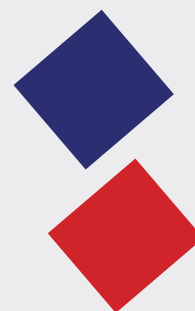
BANDING TOGETHER STILL ROCKING THE NIGHT AWAY

Banding Together X is scheduled for Saturday, September 24, at Two Brothers Roundhouse, in Aurora.

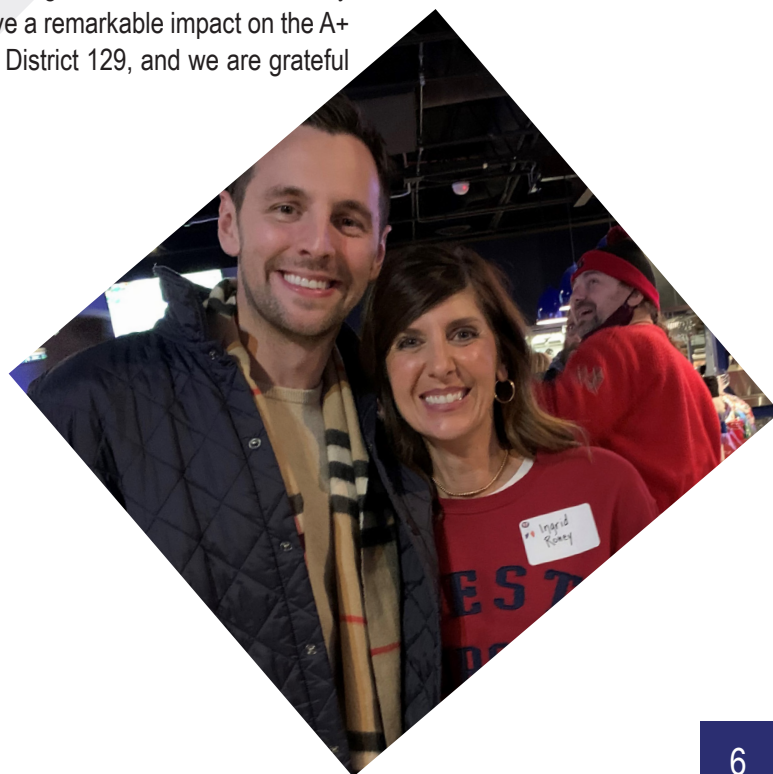


GIVING TUESDAY! TOGETHER WE GAVE!

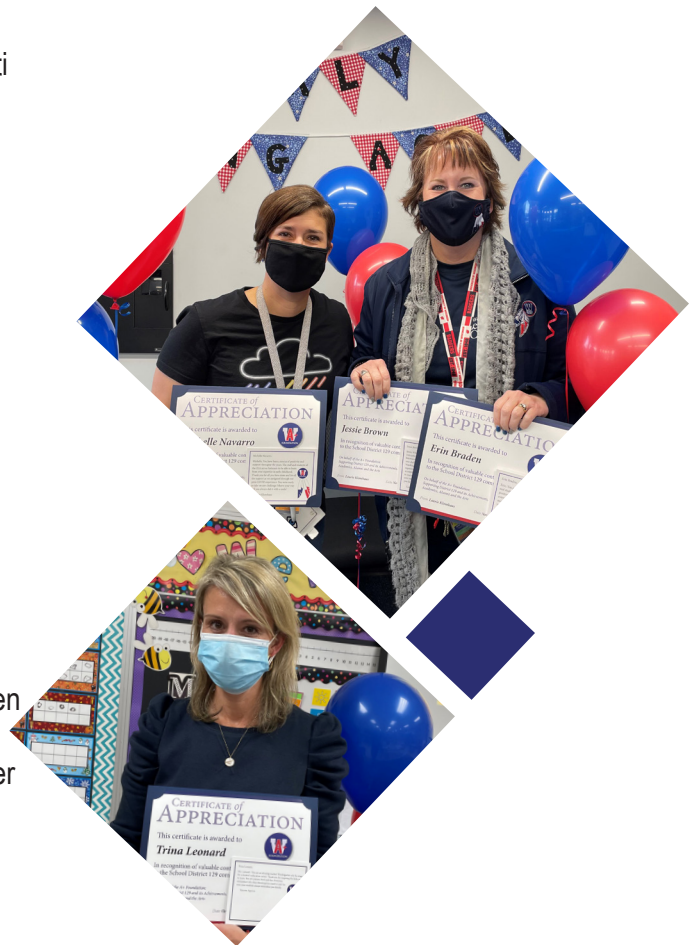

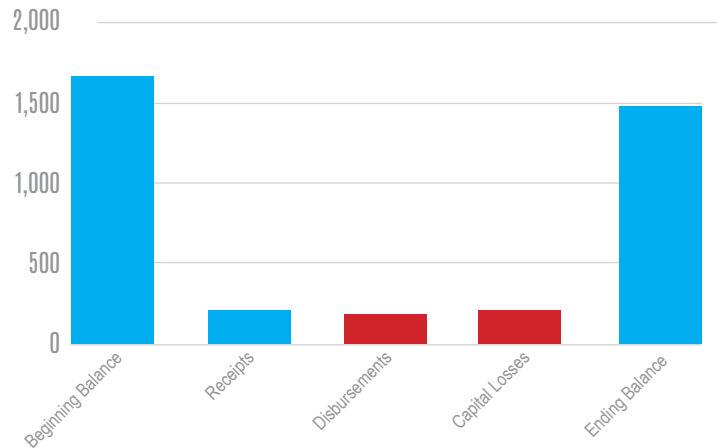
