Dear Parents, Students, and Community Members:

During the 1988-89 school year, the Red Creek Central School District, under the requirements of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), inspected all facilities for asbestos containing materials. The inspections were conducted by a professional laboratory.

The results of that inspection, and the subsequently developed management plan, were approved by the Board of Education and submitted to the State Education Department in May 1989.

Please be advised that copies of the Asbestos Management Plan, and related documentation, are available in the District Office, in each school office, and in the bus garage office. You are invited to inspect any and all materials.

Red Creek is most fortunate in that we have a very minimal problem with asbestos. The limited amounts of asbestos present are not considered a hazard to students, employees, or visitors. Some asbestos abatement was performed during the spring of 2011 as part of our capital improvement project. Re-inspections of the facilities are completed every three years in accordance with AHERA. Documentation of these activities is on file in the District Office for public review.
