<u> Open House at HMS ~ Thursday, September 15th at 6 pm</u>



School Bus Seating Assignments

Today in Homeroom, our students received an assigned bus seat for the school bus. As a rule of thumb, we strive to seat 6th grade students in the front, 7th grade in the middle of the bus, and 8th grade students in the back. These bus cards were printed on card stock; students will be asked to store their cards in a safe place so that they do not forget where they sit. Please see an example card below. Students will be asked to sit in their assigned seats moving forward. This procedure helps us tremendously with behavior management. If you or your child have any concerns about the assigned seating arrangement, please reach out to your child's school counselor.



<mark>Lunch Seats</mark>

Today, we asked our students to document their lunch seats which will remain in place for the first 9 weeks. Our students had an entire week to find a friend(s) to sit with at lunch; we have been present and vigilant to ensure all of our students feel comfortable and happy in our lunchroom. We have many adults in the lunchroom to assist our students with that challenging process, especially for our 6th graders. Please note that if for any reason your child is feeling unhappy with his or her lunch seat, he or she should go to the school counseling office and request a seat change. We are always happy to work with our students if there is an issue or unique request! We completely understand that issues or concerns may arise, and we will work with individual students to solve problems.

<mark>Cell Phones</mark>

As we shared last week, cell phones are to be turned off and out of sight during school hours from the time they enter the school building until the dismissal bell at the end of the day. We believe our students need to learn how to communicate with one another and develop their interpersonal skills during the school day. Cell phones prove to be a large distraction to our students and also potentially invite cyberbullying into the school day. Please remind your students of this rule, since we will be following our code of conduct for any cell phone infractions.
