

# Uniform Policy

The RESA uniform has four parts: shirt, bottom, shoes & ID with lanyard

## Uniform Shirt:

- The shirt must be a collared & buttoned polo shirt or button-down shirt
- The colors allowed are **white, blue, green, and black**
- Only solid colored shirts are allowed
- RESA spirit wear may be worn in place of the shirt
- School appropriate sweatshirts and sweaters may be worn over the uniform
- Hoods must always be worn down

## Uniform Bottom:

- Modest pants, skirts or shorts are required
- Colors allowed are **khaki, blue, green and black**
- No denim jeans (black jeans are okay)
- No sweatpants
- No pajama pants
- Tights or leggings may be worn under the uniform bottom.

## Uniform Shoes:

- Shoes must be closed toe
- Closed toe crocs are okay
- No sandals, flip-flops, slippers, or house shoes

## Uniform ID with lanyard:

- ID must be worn around the neck on the provided grade level lanyard
- ID must not be altered in any way
- Wearing an ID that is not yours is not allowed

## How to Wear the RESA Uniform:

- The uniform must fit appropriately
- Bottoms must be worn at the waist
- Shirts must go down to the waist even when arms are raised
- Uniform shirts and bottoms must not have holes
- No hats or headwear
- No showing any undergarments
- Bandanas and scarves worn as headbands are allowed provided they are not paisley print
- Shirts and bottoms must be solid so that they are not able to be seen through

## I.D. & Lanyard

All students will be given one I.D. and lanyard at the beginning of the year, and they are responsible for keeping them in good condition each day.

- I.D. = \$2 to replace
- Lanyard = \$1 to replace
- These items may only be purchased in the Main Office during lunch.

## Physical Education

When assigned to the pool, students will need appropriate swimwear. Girls' swimwear should be a modest one piece suit, & boys' swimwear should be swim trunks with liner.
