## COMING SOON! A NEW LOOK GOING INTO THE 25TH YEAR AT ISAAC

New London, CT— As we celebrate our 25th year anniversary, the Inter-district School for Arts and Communication is in the midst of constructing a new addition set for completion in April 2023. The design for the 3,410-square-foot addition was approved last year by the Board of Directors, developed by JCJ Architecture, and being constructed by G. Donovan Associates. The addition will add a new state of the art science classroom and lab along with a new band and chorus room. The space below the suspended addition would be utilized as outdoor space complete with artificial turf and outdoor seating.

Executive Director, Dr. Nicholas Spera stated that: “Our students and school community deserve the opportunity to learn and grow in the best facilities with the best staff. We now have the staff and soon we will have a tremendous facility to support our curricula needs.”

With construction in progress the school has shifted all parent drop off and parent pickup to the Governor Winthrop Boulevard side of the building. This will help limit the traffic on the construction side of the building and allow for the construction crew to progress safely on the addition of our new classrooms. ### AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMING AND ATHLETICS



ISAAC is heading into the second year of our 21st Century Community Learners Centers Grant (21CCCL). The grant helps fund after school programming starting on October 11th and running through May 31st of the 2022-2023 School year. Students have the ability to try many clubs including: Leadership Club, Culinary Club, Swing Band Club, Gaming Club, MathCounts Club, and Environmental Club. Each club runs for approximately nine weeks providing all students the opportunity to try different clubs over the course of each trimester.
