



## 2022-23 Advanced Placement Exam Registration Information for all Year-Long and Fall Semester Only Classes

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Friendswood High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. Use this tool, [AP Credit Policy Search](#), to find colleges that offer credit or placement for AP scores.

Please follow the steps below to register for the 2023 AP exams.

**Online Exam registration will begin on Monday, September 5, 2022, at 12:01 AM and end on Tuesday, November 8th, 2022, at 11:59 PM.** \*If you are taking a semester only (Government or Macro) AP class in the Spring, wait until January to register/sign-up for that exam.

The AP exam registration process is **TWO steps**. We recommend that the student and parent/guardian do this together. **Both must be completed in order to have AP exams ordered:**

### Step 1: Register and Pay for the AP exam(s)

Register at [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/442625](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/442625)

Indicate the AP courses you are taking this year **and** the exams you wish to take.

Receive your **join codes** and directions to complete the second required step.

The cost is **\$100** per exam. Students who qualify for a fee reduction will pay **\$62**. *In order to qualify for a fee reduction, families must complete or update the "free/reduced meals application" with the Food Services dept. before registering for AP exams.*

Exam fees may be paid online or with a check made out to Total Registration.

All payments must be made in full no later than **November 8** in order for the exam(s) to be ordered.

**Ordering Exams Late (after November 8):** Exams for year-long or fall semester ONLY courses ordered after **November 8** will incur a \$40 fee.

**Spring-only semester classes:** Registration for Spring ONLY semester classes will open January 5th, 2023.

**Canceled Exam Fees:** Exams can be canceled through Total Registration no later than **April 28, 2023** and you will receive a refund for your exam, minus the \$40 cancellation fee.

## Step 2: AP Classroom Confirmation

Login to your **College Board** account at [myap.collegeboard.org](https://myap.collegeboard.org) to confirm that you have joined AP classroom (you will use the **join codes** provided at the completion of step one)

**LAST and MOST IMPORTANT STEP-** Indicate “Yes” under the **Student Exam Decision Indicator**; the default is “Undecided.”

Tuesday March 7, 2023	11:59 PM	Registration <b>ends</b> at 11:59 pm for all Spring Semester-only classes and all LATE orders. <b>NO ORDERS WILL BE PLACED AFTER THIS DATE/TIME.</b>
Friday April 28, 2023	8:00 AM	Last day to cancel an exam through Total Registration (\$40 fee) and receive a <b>partial refund</b> . *You will not be refunded the \$40 late fee per canceled exam.
