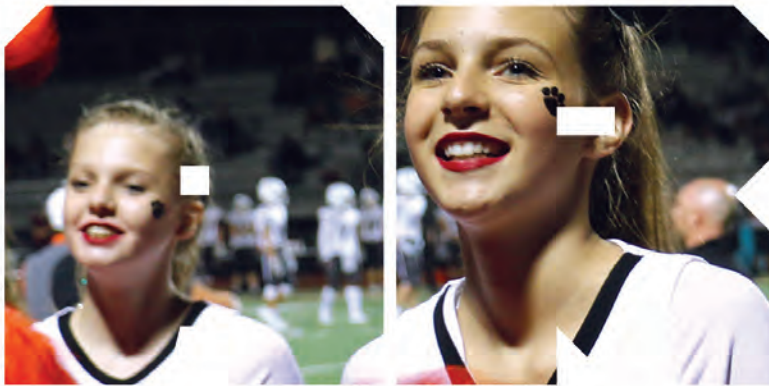

BACK TO SCHOOL INFORMATION:

Early Childhood Screening - Screen At Three

Early Childhood Screening **SCREEN @ 3** is required by the state of Minnesota for all children prior to entering kindergarten, but the best time to screen a child is between 3 and 4 years old. Screening is a brief, simple procedure used to identify potential health or developmental problems. Screening includes vision and hearing, height and weight, immunization review, large and small muscles, thinking, language and communication skills, as well as social and emotional development.

Minnesota Student Immunization Law

Minnesota Statutes Section 121A.15 and Minnesota Rules Chapter 4604 requires that each student enrolled in and remaining in an elementary or secondary school must submit a record stating that they have received immunizations consistent with medically accepted standards. Immunization records from parents or health care providers stating the month, day, and year of each dose are acceptable. If the student or parent(s) meets one of the legal exemptions - contraindication for medical reasons or contraindication for conscientiously held beliefs - the health care provider or notary needs to sign an appropriate exemption.

Vaccines required for entering kindergarten:

- Hepatitis B - three doses
- DTaP - five doses
- Polio - four doses
- MMR - two doses
- Varicella - two doses

Vaccines required for grades 1-12:

- Hepatitis B - three doses
- DTaP - three doses
- Polio - three doses
- MMR - two doses
- Varicella - two doses

Before entering 7th Grade:

- Tdap - one dose
- Meningococcal - one dose

Before entering 12th Grade:

- Meningococcal - two doses

Emergency Weather Closing

When a decision is made to close schools, an announcement will be made over major radio and television stations as early in the morning as possible. The announcement will identify our school district as White Bear Lake Area Schools. Efforts will also be made to use the parent notification alert system to notify families of school closures. If no announcement is made, schools will be in session as scheduled. Parents may also check the District website or Facebook/Twitter page, or call the White Bear Lake Area School Closing Hotline number at 651-407-7540.

Transportation

Busing information will be posted on the students' Parent Portal by August 29, 2022. Students should be at the bus stop five minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive. Students are only allowed to ride the bus to and from the school and bus stop they are assigned. Students are not allowed to ride another bus to events such as birthday parties, scouting, or other activities. Bus schedules are somewhat flexible during the first week of school while drivers become familiar with the routes.

In cases of inclement weather, bus drivers will try to maintain their schedules. However, if roads are icy or snow covered, buses may be late and parents and students should plan accordingly. Parents should use their discretion in sending children outside when the weather is extremely cold.

School Breakfast/Lunch Program / Application for Educational Benefits

For the past two years, the federal government has funded a plan to provide free school meals for K-12 school students. They have stopped providing this funding beginning in the upcoming school year so school meals will NOT be free for all students in the 2022-23 school year.

Families may qualify for free or reduced-price school meals, with a new application needing to be submitted each year. To apply, complete the Application for Educational benefits online at www.schoolcafe.com/isd624 or in paper form as soon as possible. Additional benefits may be available to students who qualify such as lower or no fees for activities, testing and more. - At the top of the page click on "Our Schools" and select your child's school.
- On the school home page select "Support" in the dark orange bar at the top of the page.
- Select "Free/Reduced Lunch." This will take you directly to the online application.
- Once you are there, create or log in to your account and fill out the application and hit the "submit my application" button.

Community Use of School District Facilities

The Community Services and Recreation Department maintains the school facility reservation schedule. Requests to use school district facilities should be made by emailing facilities@isd624.org (preferred) or through the Facilities Scheduling line at 651-407-7503. Facility details and rental agreement information can be found at isd624.org/CommunityServices.

Scheduling requests should be made at least one week prior to the desired reservation date. If the desired reservation date is less than one week from the activity date, the Community Services staff will make every effort to accommodate requests in a timely fashion.

Preschool Programs

A variety of preschool options are available at various locations in the district for children who are 3 or 4 years old by September 1st. The full day programs located in elementary sites have access to busing and Extended Day options.

Our preschools are four-star Parent Aware rated and provide developmentally appropriate, play-based education with licensed preschool teachers that get kids excited about learning. In addition, we work to align our Early Childhood program with kindergarten to ensure a more seamless transition. Elements of that alignment include use of the ECIPS (MN state early childhood standards) to guide instruction, Handwriting Without Tears, implementation of the Conscious Discipline framework for social and emotional learning, and the use of limited assessments that allow us to understand student progress.

Extended Day (School-Age Care)

Extended Day is an out-of-school time program designed to meet the needs of busy families and active kids. The program serves students in grades preK through 5th grade during the school year. Extended Day compliments the school day, encourages social and emotional growth, and emphasizes student creativity, teamwork and communication, and being active.

The program is youth-focused and choice based, giving youth the opportunity to develop strong social skills and positive relationships. Daily program activities include health and fitness, service projects, arts, creative play, language and literacy, science and more.

Extended Day provides programming before and after school, as well as full-day programming on most non-school days and during the summer. The program has daily tuition with flexible scheduling options, including regular and drop-in contracts. Limited financial assistance is available.

After school school dismissal - 6 p.m.
Non-school days..... 6:30 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Middle School Opportunities

Breakfast Club

This is a morning opportunity for students who are not able to stay home to catch the bus, live outside the district busing boundaries, or may be early risers. The program is designed to be youth-driven and is flexible enough to include student interests to drive programming. There will be recreation opportunities as well as time to complete assignments, participate in hands-on activities, and hang out with friends.

FLEX is the district's out-of-school time program for middle schoolers. The program includes a variety of opportunities for students, including academic support, recreation time, clubs, and service opportunities. It is designed to be a safe, fun, and relaxing space for students to be when not engaged in other activities or sports. In the program, students will continue their social emotional growth, receive support for academic work, and explore passions and interests of their own.

Program runs Monday through Thursday, 4-5:20 p.m. after school, and is free for current middle school students during the school year. Students may be picked up, walk or bike home, or use the activity bus.

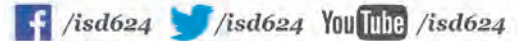

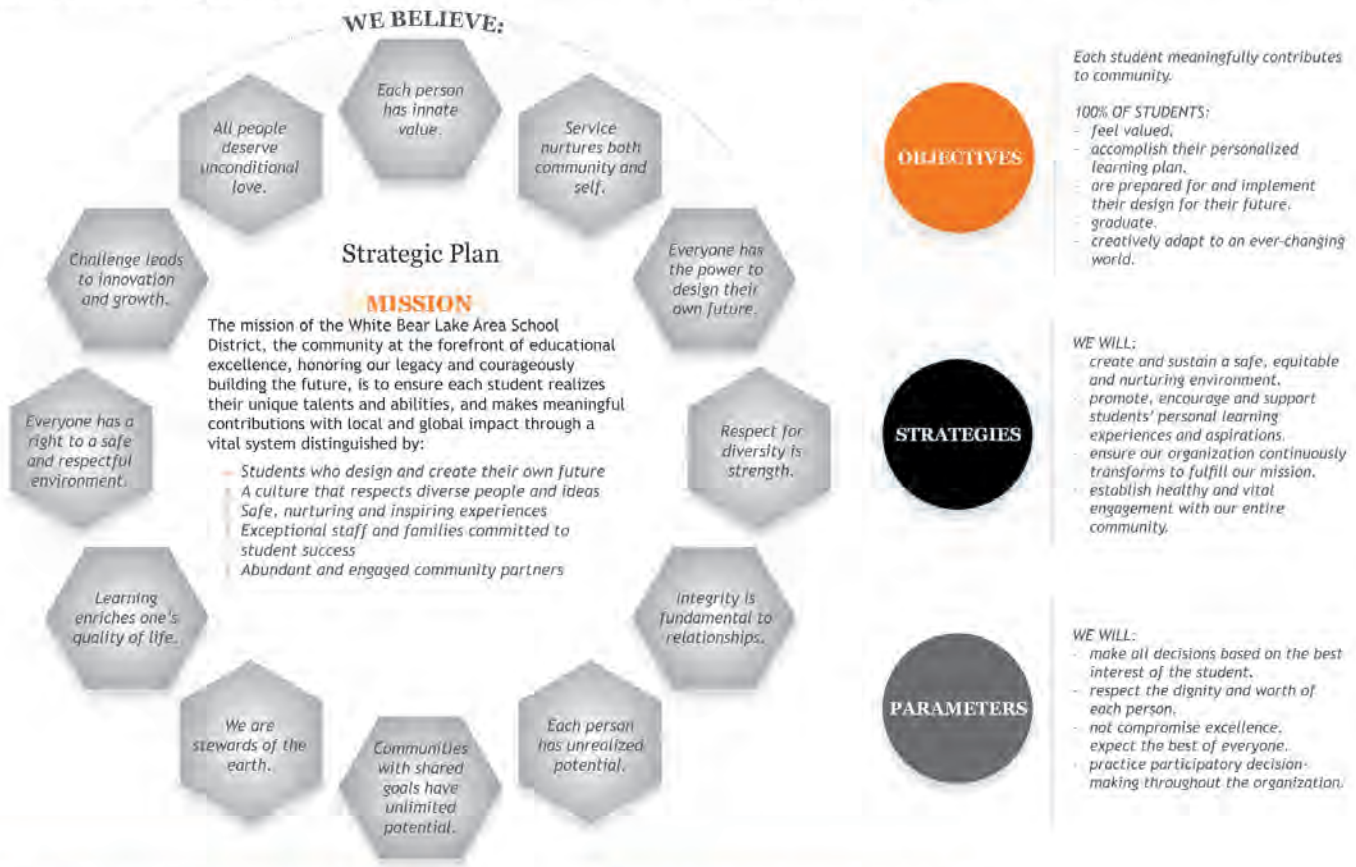

Strategic Plan

At the August 8, 2022, the School Board approved four updated Strategic Plan Strategies. In June, a group of approximately 30 community members and school district representatives gathered to examine the District's Strategic Plan. The planning team affirmed the Strategic Plans' beliefs objectives, mission, and parameters. The group also considered the concept of strategic emergence as it developed new strategies that will be the District's focus moving forward.

The four strategies that were developed and agreed upon by the planning team are:

1. We will create and sustain a safe, equitable and nurturing environment.
2. We will promote, encourage and support students' personal learning experiences and aspirations.
3. We will ensure our organization continuously transforms to fulfill our mission.
4. We will establish healthy and vital engagement with our entire community.



Building Our Future Construction Update

Since 2019, when the community supported a bond referendum, the list of completed facilities projects has grown to include the South Campus gym addition, Transportation Facility, ALC security renovation, and elementary additions at Lincoln, Matoska, Vadnais Heights and Willow Lane.

Phase 2 is in progress and includes work at Birch Lake, Lakeaires and Otter Lake Elementaries, ALC, and the addition at the current WBLAHS - South Campus, which will be a middle school building when North Campus becomes the site of the unified high school in the fall of 2024. In Hugo, the new North Star Elementary is open for students this fall and construction will begin at Oneka Elementary. Projects in the design phase include Central Middle School and Sunrise Park Middle School site's conversion to become a multi-use facility to include District Offices, Early Childhood, Transition Education Center (TEC) and the Senior Program.

Capital Projects Levy Renewal

At the July 11 regular meeting, the White Bear Lake Area School Board unanimously voted in favor of placing a capital projects levy renewal question on the November ballot. The capital projects levy contributes significantly to the ability of the District to meet its ongoing and increasing capital needs. Renewal of the levy is projected to generate \$2,590,309 annually for an additional 10 years beginning in 2024.

The tax rate for district property owners will remain unchanged, as this is a straight renewal of an existing levy.

The funds will be used in the following ways:

- **Safety and security:** The capital projects levy allows the district to maintain and increase safety and security measures and equipment throughout the district.
- **Technology and related services:** The capital projects levy allows the district to provide classroom technology, software and computers for students. Related services include the maintenance of equipment and technology staff.
- **Textbooks, curriculum materials and equipment, and musical instruments:** The capital projects levy allows the district to purchase textbooks, curriculum materials and equipment, and musical instruments according to our curriculum replacement cycle.
- **Transportation:** The capital projects levy allows the district to purchase additional buses and vans for student transportation.
