

Covid Policy (updated 08/16/2022)

We appreciate your support during these past few years, and the measures you have undertaken to help keep our campus healthy. As a community, we rely on each other to continue to help maintain the health and wellbeing of our school. As we return to AYA, there has been a full review of our current Covid policies and the following changes will be implemented immediately.

- Please keep your student home if they are showing Covid symptoms. Students who develop symptoms while at school, will be sent home. Common symptom can include (but are not limited to): fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, headache, muscle or body aches, fatigue, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.
- There will be no testing done at school.
- If your student tests positive at any point, quarantine for 5 days. Return on day 6, or later, when 24 hours symptom free.
- Please report all positive test results to the School Nurse
- Close contacts will not require quarantine if asymptomatic. If symptomatic, please test or reach out to the School Nurse for further instructions. Testing is recommended on day 5.
- If a Family member is positive, test student immediately and then again on day 5. Student may attend school if asymptomatic and has a negative test result.
- Counting of days:
 - Day of exposure counts as Day "0"
 - For a positive case, Day "0" is EITHER day of symptom onset, OR day of positive test result, whichever comes earlier.

Akiba Yavneh will continue to notify families of Covid cases at school. Our policy is subject to change based on Covid conditions in and around our Campus. As always, please reach out to the School Nurse with any questions.
