#### **Bishop Kenny High School Homecoming Dance Guidelines**

Students' attire <u>MUST</u> be appropriate for a Catholic high school setting. The following guidelines have been established by the administration with the assistance of Student Council:

## ACCEPTABLE DANCE ATTIRE (Girls):

Dress or skirt <u>(No more than 3 inches above the middle of the knee)</u>

Skirt with blouse covering midriff

Bare-back above the waistline

Spaghetti strap, strapless

Jeans or khakis with blouse covering midriff

### UNACCEPTABLE DANCE ATTIRE (Girls):

T-shirts/tank tops/tube tops/shorts

Revealing/plunging neckline/halter tops

Bare-back below the waistline

Open midriff or cutouts (front, back or sides)

Dress/skirt length or slits greater than 3 inches above the middle of the knee

## ACCEPTABLE DANCE ATTIRE (Boys):

Polo or Collared dress shirt

Jeans/Khakis/Shorts (no shorter than 4" above the knee)

Ties or bowties (ties are not required)

### UNACCEPTABLE DANCE ATTIRE (Boys):

T-shirts/Tank Tops/Running Shorts

- Administrators and faculty chaperones have the right to refuse entry to <u>ANY</u> student found to be out of compliance with regards to attire. <u>NO refunds will be granted.</u>
- Questions about attire or what you plan to wear??? Take a photo in the dressing room and show to Dean Wray before making any purchases.

✤ <u>ALL</u> students must present a dance ticket and BKHS ID or photo ID for admission.

## • TICKETS ARE NON-TRANSFERRABLE

ANYONE leaving the dance/exiting through any doors (intentionally or unintentionally) will <u>NOT</u> be readmitted to the dance for ANY reason.

# **EXPECTATIONS:**

- <u>ALL</u> students WILL abide BKHS school rules and follow the guidelines for attire: NO ALCOHOL, VAPES, E-CIGARETTES, TOBACCO, DRUGS OR WEAPONS!
- Students will <u>NOT</u> be permitted to return to cars for ANY items, i.e., phones, cameras, personal items, etc.
- ANY student deemed under the influence of controlled substances will have his/her parents called by the police to pick him/her up.
- ALL students in attendance will be subject to random breathalyzing, at the discretion of the administrator(s) supervising the dance.
- > Behaviors deemed inappropriate by faculty chaperones will <u>NOT</u> be tolerated.
- > <u>ALL</u> dance styles <u>MUST</u> comply with standards of modesty and safety.
  - The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dance styles.
- Students violating any of these rules may have their parents phoned and will be asked to leave the dance. No refunds will be issued in the event of an expulsion from the dance.
- <u>ANYONE</u> in violation of these stated Guidelines and/or BKHS School Rules will face disciplinary consequences as per the BKHS Student Code of Conduct.
