Curriculum governance is a paramount responsibility shared by members of the Board. Following the establishment of a BOE Curriculum Committee last fall, the committee received department updates and reports on special programs throughout the year.

While the full Board continues to vote on matters regarding curriculum, the committee was established to:

- receive and/or request curriculum studies or presentations on specific topics;
- review data to determine curriculum effectiveness;
- review curriculum updates from summer institutes;
- review curriculum of newly approved courses; and,
- ensure policy alignment.

The first committee meeting of the 2022-2023 school year will focus on summer curriculum work as well as a look ahead to the teaching and learning priorities for this school year. Continuing with a process of regular updates and transparency with teaching and learning, the following overview is suggested to support the committee's general workflow for the duration of the school year. 

SUMMER CURRICULUM / 6-12 ENGLISH



ENGLISH A

Reviewed best practices for vocabulary instruction and embedded those practices throughout the reading units.



ENGLISH 10

Redesigned the course to place the focus on different perspectives and how they shape our understanding of storytelling, ourselves, and the world.



OTHER

Developed curriculum and lessons for new senior course (The Literature of NYC) and new blended learning elective (Digital Journalism).

6-12 ENGLISH: ENGLISH 10

One of the learning goals for our 300-level English 10 course is to broaden our students' perspectives, going beyond, through reading and writing in order to achieve a better understanding of the real world. This summer, the teachers of the course met to redesign the course to achieve this goal.

- The group began by prioritizing the course learning standards in reading, writing, speaking and listening, and language usage. They also prioritized a VoG competency, an ISTE standard, along with key concepts and terms.
- These elements, along with the revised essential question of the course ("How does perspective shape our understanding of storytelling, ourselves, and the world?") served as the basis for the design of the final exam.
- Each unit was created in a similar backwards design manner, with the prioritized standards and essential questions driving the focus of the unit assessments.
- The literary content of the course was revised somewhat to allow for a greater focus on "perspective" (e.g. a shift from Macbeth to Twelfth Night).

THE SUMMER IN SOCIAL STUDIES



- 8th Grade revised a curriculum unit and completed Eduplanet21 planning for stage 1, 2, 3
- 7th Grade revised a curriculum unit and completed Eduplanet21 planning for stage 1, 2, 3
- 10th grade (World Studies 300) completed Stage 1 for all units in the course
- 11th Grade (American History 300) completed Stage1 for all units in the course



WORLD LANGUAGES (K-5)

- Formed K-5 Curriculum team (Composed of K-5 WL Coordinator and two teachers)
- Established K-12 Long Term Transfer Goals in summer
- Curriculum work is in progress:
 - Summer 2022: Team met to finalize K-5 units creating our "Curriculum Overview" (Completed)
 - Team will now begin updating units adding them to EduPlanet
 - Work will begin mid-September
 - Goal: Two units per grade (K-5) by June 2023
 - Summer 2023: Final two units for each grade

WORLD LANGUAGES 6-12

- Established **K-12 Long Term Transfer Goals** in summer; trained 6-12 teachers during August PD
- Curriculum work in "phases": update current curricula and adapt it to EduPlanet
- Phase 1: a team of Department Chair and four teachers worked over the summer to add these courses work is complete
- Phase 2: A new team will update these curricula and add them to EduPlanet during the school year work will begin at the end of September
- Phase 3: Summer 2023



DARIEN HIGH SCHOOL EXCEL PROGRAM

- Matched known curricula to areas of study EXCEL Math, EXCEL Reading, EXCEL Writing, Life Skills, Community
- Strategised implementation plans in alignment IEP goals and objectives
- Created a calendar template to map out curriculum on the 8 day cycle month by month for the 2022-2023 school year
- Ongoing development of online platform to foster family carry-over and staff integration
- Created a plan to increase social opportunities for authentic integration during the school day



TECHNOLOGY AND ENGINEERING EDUCATION

- Vertical alignment of courses from grades 6-12 is being established over the course of the next three years
- <u>Course/Career pathways</u> for students have been established at the high school
 - Gaps in those pathways are being identified and addressed over the course of the next
 3-5 years
- Sports Marketing has been added ('22-'23 school year) to fulfill a need in the Business Marketing pathway
- Principles of Engineering (P.O.E) has been updated to include a focus in robotics engineering
