How will parents be informed?

There will be a student/parent meeting on February 11th. Every student is highly encouraged to attend the virtual meeting to complete the application. What is the criteria to continue in the program in high school?

Students must maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA each semester.

Students must earn final course grade of C or better.
