3) Superintendent Report

Superintendent Josh Hurt

- Some Kentucky districts are altering bus schedules and school days to make up for the staff shortages. Right now, our district is in good shape. We have bus routes and jobs filed, and we are ready to start school on Aug. 29.
- We had a great experience at the annual KASA summer conference. Metcalfe County was well-represented. Our Sources of Strength program won the Student Impact Grant and Ofc. Michael Taylor was one of three finalists for the Fred Award. He did not win, but he still received a plaque and \$250.
- Opening Day for staff is Aug. 25. There will be breakfast, vendors, and speakers. Aug. 19 is the first day of school.
- On agenda item 5H, this is the second ready. The first read was in June. There are no changes.
- On 5G, athletics is asking the board to create two middle school concession stand worker positions. Middle school athletics will pay the stipends for the positions. It's hard to find people to work the middle school concession stand. The stipend is for two \$1,000 positions.
- On 5E, it's time to set the tax rates again. A couple of years ago, we kept the tax rate the same at 53.8 cents. Last year the compensating rate lowered it to 52. This year, we want to take another step to lower that tax rate again to 51.7 cents with .1 exoneration for a total rate of 51.8 cents. This would essentially lower tax rates for the second straight year.

- Item 5A, the Community Work Transition Program (CWTP) MOA Memorandum of Agreement, allows us to continue the work that Ms. Krissy Billingsley does at the high school with the work program for our special needs students. This is one of the best programs we offer for special needs students.
- 5B is a speech contract for Ms. Mary Ann Forbes at the middle school and high school. It's more cost-effective than hiring a full-time SLP.
- 5F is a contract with Glasgow for hearing and vision services. Ms. Charlotte Roach will provide those services.
- Monroe County, Hart County, and Cumberland County may also be interested in contract services with Ms. Roach.

- We have received a PEEP (Project Early Entry Plan) grant. The \$25,000 will be used to improve the pipeline of Teaching and Learning career pathway participants by providing students access to intro classes and opportunities in the teaching profession. Ms. Ethridge will be teaching EDU 250 and 260 this year to begin our education pathway. The goal is to help students graduate college sooner and return to Metcalfe County to teach.
- We will be traveling to Green and Monroe vocational schools to provide trade opportunities for our students. There are a total of 11 certified pathways for 65 of our students.
- Dual Credit classes at our universities started this week. We are providing opportunities for students at several universities, such as SKYCTC, WKU, and Murray State. We will also have dual credit classes at MCHS.
- Freshman Transition Day will be on August 24th from 9-2.
- Back to School Bash will be on August 25th from 3-5.
- Fall Formal will be September 10th at the Old School Gym this year.
- Hayden Hawkins is the Barren River Region Tractor Driving Champion.

Athletics typically pays each group working the concession stand \$100. Each group works approximately five times a year for a total of \$500. Athletics will still budget and pay each group \$500.


