Standards-Based Learning and Assessment

ICS uses a standards-based approach for reporting student learning in the high school. In each course, teachers cover a variety of standards and rate student performance against grade-level standards based on the following scale: **Exemplary, Meeting, Approaching, Support Needed, and No Progress**


Students are required to take 0.5 credits of Bible for each year enrolled at ICS. Students are required to take 0.25 credits of Week Without Walls, for each spring semester enrolled in HS. Students who do not attend must complete an additional pre-arranged total of 50 hours of community service.

How do we calculate GPA?

Only classes taken at ICS or through NorthStar Academy are calculated in a student's GPA. Students receive an extra 0.5 point for honors courses and an extra 1.0 point for AP courses added to their GPA. ICS does not rank students.

Advanced Placement & SAT/ACT Performance

In 2022, 53 ICS students took 105 AP exams. Students take AP courses either at ICS or online through Northstar Academy.
