

Standards-Based Learning and Assessment

ICS uses a standards-based approach for reporting student learning in the high school. In each course, teachers cover a variety of standards and rate student performance against grade-level standards based on the following scale: **Exemplary, Meeting, Approaching, Support Needed,** and **No Progress**

How do we calculate GPA?


Only classes taken at ICS or through NorthStar Academy are calculated in a student's GPA. Students receive an extra 0.5 point for honors courses and an extra 1.0 point for AP courses added to their GPA. ICS does not rank students.

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Advanced Placement & SAT/ACT Performance

In 2022, 53 ICS students took 105 AP exams. Students take AP courses either at ICS or online through Northstar Academy.
