Mrs Brown will invite faculty and students to the hall at approximately 8:35. The ceremony will last approximately 10 minutes. Thank you for your silent respect and for remembering our fellow Americans lost that day.

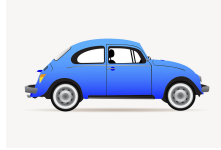
#### **Last year's yearbooks have arrived!**
