# Traffic Patterns

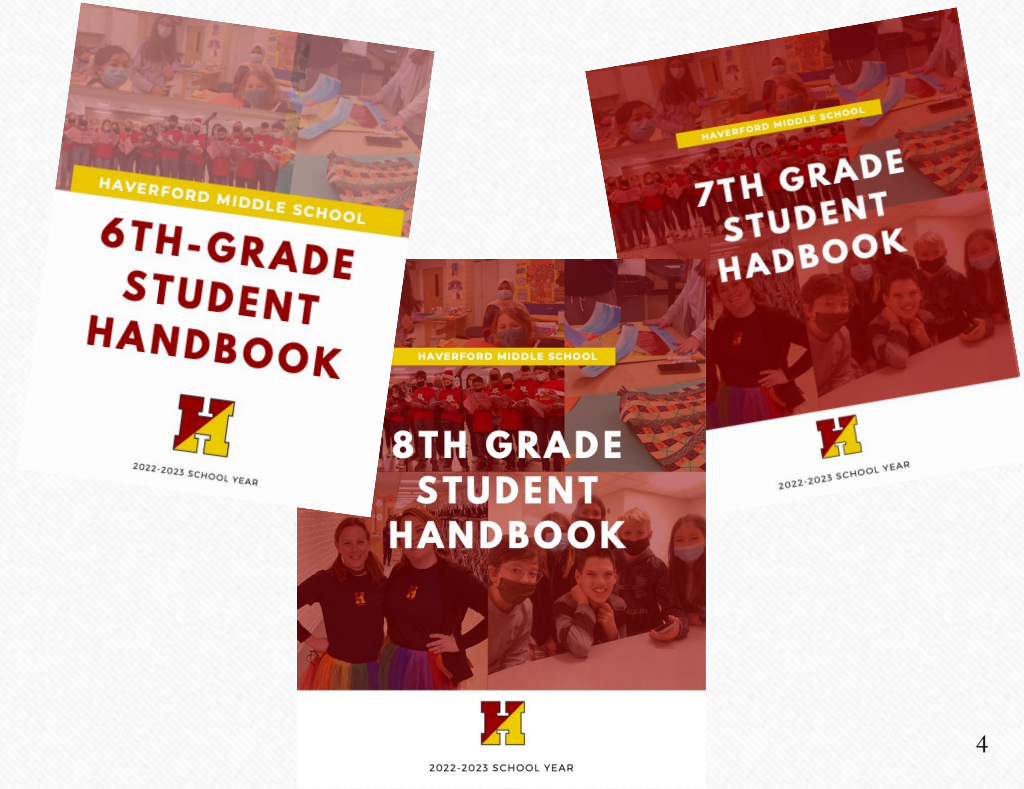
---

- **Parking spaces on campus are for staff**
- **Parking for families going to the main office are on Darby Road where the flag pole is located**

- **Families should drop off students on Marthart Avenue, Golf Road, or Darby Road**
- **Students should cross Darby Road at that the crosswalk where the crossing guards are located**

# Arrival

- Please do not arrive before 7:30 AM if possible
- Students will be admitted to the building at 7:30 AM
- We will post signs at the grade level entrances

  - 7<sup>th</sup> grade – Darby Road & Golf Road
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade – Golf Road & Greenway Road
- The administrative and counseling team will be positioned at the entrances for arrival





# Lockers

- Approved times to use locker:
  - Arrival
  - Before/after lunch
  - Dismissal
  - With teacher permission
- Jackets, book bags, and cell phones should be kept in the locker

- **Late arrivals**
  - Students must report to the main office if they arriving after 7:50 AM
  - Provide your child with a note detailing the reason for their lateness
- **Absences**
  - You may email Mrs. Sharon Cianci ([scianci@haverfordsd.net](mailto:scianci@haverfordsd.net)) if your child is going to be absent from school
  - If you do not email Mrs. Cianci, then please provide your child with a note when they return to school
  - Absent notes should be delivered to Mrs. Cianci in the main office
- **Early dismissal**
  - Please provide your child with a note for an early dismissal
  - Early dismissal notes should be delivered to the main office upon entering school
