About the Program

The American Heritage Schools Pre-Medical Program is a 4-year program beginning in 9th grade and culminating in 12th grade with an internship. In order to fulfill the requirements of the program, students must complete a total of 9 academic credits (8 required and 1 elective). In order to complete the program, students must take seven classes each semester and are required to maintain a 3.5 GPA in all Pre-Med courses in order to remain in the program. Students must earn a B or higher in each course in order to move on to the next course in the program. All of the Pre-Professional Programs are taught daily by medical doctors, attorneys, judges, engineers, computer scientists, business leaders, and entrepreneurs.



Top Instructors

The program is taught daily by adjunct or full-time teachers who are practicing physicians, such as neurologists, pathologists, infectious disease specialists, ER doctors, etc. The program is taught at the college level using college level textbooks and curriculum.

The program culminates in a senior year internship where students experience the practice of medicine in real life.
