About the Program

The American Heritage Schools Pre-Law Program is a 4-year program beginning in 9th grade and culminating in 12th grade with an internship. In order to fulfill the requirements of the program, students must complete a total of 5 credits. In order to remain in the program, students must maintain a 3.75 cumulative GPA and a B or higher in law classes. All of the Pre-Professional Programs are taught daily by medical doctors, attorneys, judges, engineers, computer scientists, business leaders, and entrepreneurs.
