About the Program

The American Heritage Schools Business & Entrepreneurship Program is a 4-year program beginning in 9th grade and culminating in 12th grade with an internship and Senior Capstone project. In order to fulfill the requirements of the program, students must complete a total of 4.5 credits. Students are required to maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA and must earn a B or higher in each Business course to remain in the program. All of the Pre-Professional Programs are taught daily by medical doctors, attorneys, judges, engineers, computer scientists, business leaders, and entrepreneurs.
