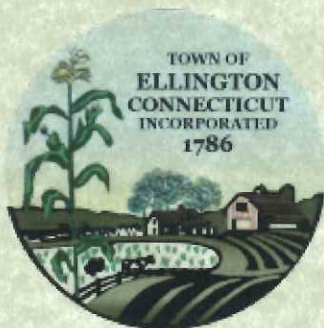
Whereas, Robert and Margaret Dawson were great contributors to both the Town of Ellington and the greater community as resourceful and committed public servants; and
