DEVICE USER AGREEMENT

This Device User Agreement ensures that the borrowed equipment supplied by the Paradise Valley Unified School District will be used and maintained in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, by the designated student named below. By signing this form, the student will demonstrate reasonable care with the respect to the security and physical well-being of the equipment signed to his/her care. In the absence of reasonable care or if the equipment is returned in a condition different than the original condition, the student will be financially responsible. In addition, in the event that Paradise Valley Unified School District determines in its sole discretion that the borrower did not utilize reasonable care in the use of the equipment, the student will be responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen equipment. All specified equipment is and shall at all times remain the property of the District and will be verified that it is still within the student's possession annually and must be returned by the student's last day of enrollment in the school district. More information will follow regarding the Optional Protection Plan and reduced repair/replacement cost. There is no technology rental fee as enrollment in this plan is completely optional.

To the extent Borrower is a minor, a parent must sign this agreement. By signing this agreement, both the Borrower and Parent agree:

- To abide by the Paradise Valley Unified School District Digital Citizenship and Device Usage Policies.
To use the equipment for educational use only.
All district managed devices will filter and log web content when connected to any network.
To report any problems, damages, misuse, or misconduct immediately to the advisor or administrator.
That the equipment is the property of the District and must be returned prior to the student's last day of attendance.
To return the equipment before the student's last day of school if the student is transferring out of the District or long-term suspended.
That if the equipment is not returned to the District in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, or if the equipment is damaged, lost, or stolen, due to student's negligence or not utilizing reasonable care in the use of the equipment, reasonable wear and tear excepted as determined exclusively by the District, the student agrees to be financially responsible for the replacement value of the equipment as determined by the District.
That all information stored on equipment carries no expectation of privacy and is property of the District. Any information or use of the equipment carries no expectation of privacy. The District reserves the right, at all times and without prior notice, to inspect and search any and all its property for the purpose of determining whether any policy has been violated, or when an inspection and investigation is necessary for purposes of promoting safety or compliance with state and federal laws.

Parent/Guardians may select among the following options for ensuring their student has a device for accessing the curriculum, resources, and assessments:

- YES - Purchase Optional Protection Plan: Parent/Guardian can allow the student to check out a school-provided device and enroll in the Optional Device Protection Plan which requires a \$30 non-refundable fee (Retain receipt as proof of enrollment).
NO - Decline Optional Protection Plan: Parent/Guardian can allow the student to check out a district-provided device and not enroll in the Optional Device Protection Plan. Parent/Guardian will assume full financial responsibility for the school-issued mobile device. Replacement Cost - \$393
