Type 5 ~ The Twice Exceptional

- → Physically or emotionally challenged
- → Potential learning disability
- → Not proficient in English
- → The school system focuses on their weaknesses
- → Typically is not identified

Type 6 ~ The Autonomous Learner

- → Very few operate at this level at an early age
- → Works well within the school system
- → Uses the school system to create new opportunities
- → Respected by adults and peers
- → Independent and self-directed
