

What: The PSAT/NMSQT is the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. The 2022 PSAT/NMSQT is the qualifying test students take to enter the [National Merit® Scholarship Program](#) and to compete for recognition and college scholarships to be awarded in 2023.

Who: All **10th and 11th grade students** are required to participate in testing. **Select 9th** graders who were invited to test and registered will also participate.

All other 9th and all 12th grade students will **not report to campus this day.*

When: Wednesday, October 12, 2022

Where: Friendswood High School (testing room locations will be posted in the main malls the week prior to testing).

PSAT/NMSQT Schedule	
8:20-8:40 AM	Students start arriving to testing rooms by 8:20 AM. As students enter the rooms they need to find their assigned seat, turn off cell phones/electronic devices, and take a seat.
8:40 AM	All students should be in their testing room by this time.
8:40-9:30 AM	Begin the Preadministration Session
9:30 AM	Begin the timed portion of the exam
1:30 PM	**ESTIMATE: Standard Time Testing should be completed around 1:30 PM.
Students will be dismissed from testing once all standard testing rooms have finished the exam (approximately 1:30 PM). Once dismissed from testing students are expected to leave campus.	

Information Regarding Transportation
<p>Buses will be picking up at 1:45 PM for all standard time testers. <i>*Students testing with College Board-approved extended time will need to arrange for transportation when they finish testing.</i></p> <p>Car Riders will be permitted to text parents to pick them up once they are dismissed from testing.</p> <p>Student Drivers will be leave campus once dismissed from their testing room.</p>
