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Learner Demographics Our district served approximately during the 2021-2022 school year according to the Pennsylvania Department of Education. 11 of every 30 learners were African American. 6 of every 30 learners were White. 5 of every 30 learners were Hispanic/Latino. 5 of every 30 learners were Asian. 3 of every 30 learners represented two or more races. **18 of every 30** learners qualified for free/ reduced-priced school lunches. 2 of every 30 learners were English Learners. learners qualified for Special Education services.
