This authorization would renew the school district's existing authorization which is scheduled to expire after taxes payable in 2022. The proposed capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$1,253,030 for taxes payable in 2023, the first year it is to be levied, and would be authorized for ten years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$12,530,300. The additional revenue from the proposed capital project levy authorization will provide continued funds for the acquisition, replacement, maintenance and support of instructional technology and software, devices, equipment, networks, security, operational infrastructure, and technology support personnel.</p>
