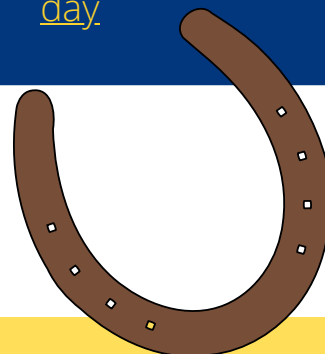

We are SO excited to present the Kindness Club to Snow Horse Elementary—a program where EVERYONE (adults and kids) is a member. Random Acts of Kindness (Apr/May)



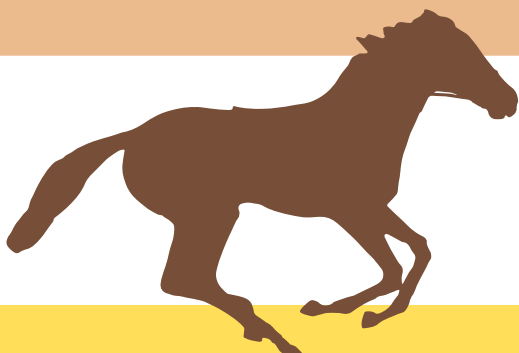

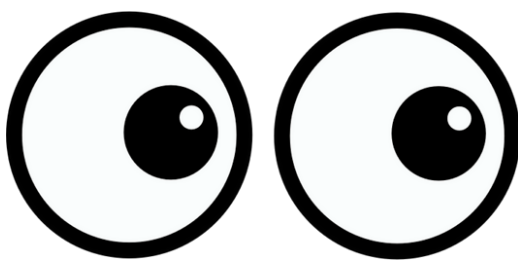
