1. Approval of Orangevale Renovation Project Funding Support

- Comment: CMP applied for and was granted preliminary approval for a facilities renovation project with a total cost of \$8,568,364 at the Orangevale Campus in December of 2018. The original award did not include all of the spaces at the school site as some spaces were being utilized by San Juan Unified School District preschool programs. Subsequently, the San Juan Unified School District decided to make the entire campus available to CMP for this renovation project. A second application was submitted and an additional \$3,194,280 was preliminarily approved in October of 2022. Project costs are expected to exceed the total available project funds. San Juan Unified has asked CMP to help cover overage costs.
- **Recommendation:** The Board is requested to authorize the Superintendent to financially contribute to the Orangevale project up to a certain amount through a one-time payment and/or state loan option.

2. Approval of Capitol Renovation Project Funding Support

- **Comment**: CMP applied for and was granted preliminary approval for a facilities renovation project with a total cost of \$10,760,142 at the Capitol Campus on October 26, 2022.
- **Recommendation**: The Board is requested to authorize the Superintendent to work with Sacramento City Unified School District on the project and contribute up to a certain amount through a one-time payment and/or state loan option so long as CMP gains access to the entirety of the campus.

3. Appointment of Business Representative (1)

- **Comment**: The Board has been provided a recommendation as to an appointment to serve as the Business Representative (1) on the CMP-Governing Board. The appointment will be valid through the end of the term, June 30, 2024.
