**Physical Abuse* – the non-accidental injury of a child under 18 years of age which is the result of actions by a parent, guardian, or other designated (temporary or permanent) caretaker *Sexual Abuse* – contacts or interaction involving the use of children for sexual stimulation *Emotional Abuse* – any injury to the mental or psychological capacity of emotional stability of a child noted and evidenced by a substantial and observable impairment in his/her ability to function within a normal range of performance and behavior with due regard to age, development, culture, and environment *Neglect* – inadequate or dangerous child-rearing practices such as inadequate supervision, food, clothing shelter, education or medical care *Dependency* – a child who is not receiving adequate care of supervision, but it is not through the fault of the parent (parent is physically ill or injured, family suffers a natural disaster, fire or flood)

**In order to protect the child, it is essential that abuse involving school personnel be reported to the principal.
