

What Qualifies for Community Service?

- Any nonprofit organizations such as but not limited to
 - GRACE
 - Churches, Synagogues, Mosques
 - Salvation Army
 - Public Libraries
 - Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of America
 - Red Cross
 - American Cancer Society
 - Habitat for Humanity
 - United Way
 - American Heart Association
 - Alzheimer's Association
 - Carroll Education Foundation
 - Rise Adaptive Sports
 - Activities associated with your Home Owners Association (HOA)
 - Humane Society
- Mission trips (a maximum of 40 hours per trip)
- Teen Court
- Hospitals (delivering flowers, give directions or escort visitors, cashier, transport patients)

What Does Not Qualify for Community Service?

- Activities for which students receive direct benefit or compensation/pay are excluded (i.e., fundraising for a field trip, special training, internships, etc.)
- Fostering animals at home or driving to pick up animals to foster
- Helping your neighbor (babysitting, mowing, picking up their trash, etc.)
- For profit summer camps
- Training for any summer camp positions
- Orientation or training for volunteer opportunities
- Activities performed during the school day **(If a student completes Community Service during an off block, please note on the submission of hours that it was done during their off block.)**
- Hosting a foreign exchange student
- Hours performed as part of a Teen Court citation
- Volunteering in a medical, attorney's, CPA's or any business that is for profit
- Driving to and from to perform volunteer hours
- Club meetings for school
- Independently Tutoring or privately coaching children in sports
- For profit theaters
- Defensive Driving
