Minutes –Public Hearing – August 11, 2022

Hearing called to hear and act upon a request for Certificate of Appropriateness from the Vernon Historical Society Inc. to remove and reinstall twenty-one restored wood windows and to remove and reinstall the existing aluminum storm windows at the Grange Hall located at 734 Hartford Turnpike, Vernon.

1. Hearing called to order at 7:34 pm. Members present include, Hurd, Trapp, Olson, Nicholson, and Saucier. Hurd and Trapp recused themselves. Nicholson sat for Quinn. Olson sat as acting chair.
2. Jean Luddy from the Vernon Historical Society and Museum Director explained the details of the work. The Vernon Historical Society would like to remove and restore the existing twenty-one wood windows and aluminum storm windows at the existing openings on all four sides of the original 1928 Grange Hall located at 734 Hartford Turnpike, Vernon.
