

Family Food Box

There are times when families face difficult circumstances. The uncertain times that we are living in now can be challenging for many. Families may be faced with making difficult decisions when it comes to providing for their families. The Johnson County School System Family Resource Center (FRC) wants help such families. **The FRC now has family food boxes/bags for families with students in the Johnson County School System.** These boxes/bags are prepackaged and include non-perishable items. The essentials such as bread, milk, and eggs will be purchased and added once the referral is received. The self-referral form, *Family Support Services Form*, is located on this same site. Once you have completed and submitted the self-referral, and **it is verified that you are the parent/legal guardian of the student**, you will be contacted when your box/bag is complete and ready for pick up. We will make two attempts to call you. We will leave a message if possible. Please understand that if you do not return our call or pick up the items within two days, the items will be returned to the FRC pantry for other families.

The family food boxes are made available through funding from a grant received from the Johnson County Community Foundation, an affiliate of the East Tennessee Foundation.
